Dear Pastor,  
Warmest Christian greetings from the beloved brethren here.  
We praise God for the great work you are doing for the Lord.  
Evangelism Outreach Ministries is dedicated to the furtherance  
of the Kingdom of Christ here. We are endeavouring to reach some  
unreached areas with the Gospel. We are right now praying that God  
may supply us finances to enable us to travel and stage  
meetings in 2 distant places from here 160 and 180 miles away  
where there are allegations of cannibalism and a lot of evil  
powers. We are willing and ready to go there but we are con-  
fined up because of lack of money.

Uganda is an inland country in Eastern Africa and got  
independence on 9.10.62 but has been undergoing the horror of  
tyranny including a decade of persecution of Christianity by  
dictator Genral Idi Amin who is alleged to have personally killed  
the Anglican archbishop.

To-day the country is better governed, but people are hungry,  
industries are just beginning, costs and prices are one of the  
highest you could find in the world while the majority of workers  
earn the equivalent of US \$ 2 dollars a month as a living  
wage! People are sick and there is no enough drought  
particularly in rural areas, few clinics, the majority of the  
school children are out of school because the high cost of  
education and worse of all about 1 million (17,0522)  
Ugandans out of 16 million population is with aids.

To-day, more than ever, it is critically important to  
spread the healing message of the Gospel in this part of  
the world torn by wars, poverty, corruption, anger, confusion,  
despair and AIDS.

Friend, poverty is overwhelming, our needs are great  
and yet very little evangelistic work has been done. By  
virtue of your common union with Jesus Christ and common  
mission, we are appealing to you to render us ANY possible  
assistance.

Pastor, remember how the destruction of the city by the  
Romans had brought about insupportable misery and oppression  
upon them that are in the various churches collections were taken  
for these poor ones. The congregation at Macedonia had especially  
shown their love and fellowship to the saints. May the beloved  
saints of your congregation become Macedonians towards us.  
Beloved, we need any assistance within your reach though  
we don't have a public address system, money to buy  
medicines for our mobile clinic etc. etc.

Surely there is no where we can turn for support and  
care but in the brotherhood of believers there is our  
Christian family. It would be a most gratifying gesture  
if you could bring our burden to the attention  
of the beloved saints of your congregation.
